

JACK OF SPADES HOUSE RULES

1. A new deck of cards for each game started.
2. Cards will be placed into security envelopes and sealed.
3. In a public location, the full deck of 52 cards and 2 Jokers are to be placed in sealed envelopes. Two co-chairs will sign the back of each envelope. All envelopes will then be mixed up and numbered 1 to 54.
4. After cards are shuffled and numbered, no less than 3 Fraternal Order of Police (F.O.P.) members will place them in a locked cabinet at Thee Green Street Tavern, 37700 Green Street, New Baltimore, MI 48047. ONLY key holders will have access to the cabinet. Key holders of the cabinet are Larry Smith, Bill Gray and Don Drozdowski.
5. Tickets will be sold for \$1.00 each.
6. Drawing dates will be the last Tuesday of each month starting on May 29, 2011 and ending no later than April 24, 2012.
7. Four tickets will be drawn, one at a time, and the winning ticket holder will pick a card from the board. If the first person does not pick the Jack of Spades, the second will then be drawn. If a person does pick the Jack of Spades, the raffle has ended.
8. To win the pot, you must pick the Jack of Spades.
9. If the Jack of Spades is not drawn, the pot rolls over to the next drawing date.
10. Loosing cards will be placed in cabinet in place of the drawn envelope.
11. The pot will continue to build until the Jack of Spades is drawn. If the Jack is not drawn by April 24, 2012 the drawing will continue on that date until the Jack is drawn and the prize awarded.
12. If you are not going to be present at the drawing, you must declare an envelope number written on your ticket stub. If that number is not available, the closest number to it moving up, will be drawn. If no number is chosen, a F.O.P. member will draw your envelope. Winners will receive the same percentage of the jackpot whether they are present or not.
13. If the winning ticket holder picks the Jack of Spades, they will receive 60% of the pot. The F.O.P. will get the other 40%.
14. The F.O.P. will withhold federal taxes of 25% from the winnings where applicable. You will be required to provide proper identification and information for taxes. All tickets and monies will be accounted for by the F.O.P. in accordance with all lottery bureau requirements.

15. If the State Gaming License runs out during the game, tickets will be sold and drawn the last night until someone draws the Jack of Spades and wins the current pot.
16. If your ticket is drawn and you draw the pay card, you will receive the pay card prize and the prize for that stage ticket drawing. Example: \$50.00 for getting your ticket drawn + \$50.00 for the Joker = \$100.00. (stage 1)
17. Tickets may be purchased at the restaurant.
18. Ticket sales start on Tuesday May 3 and will continue until 9:15 p.m. on the last Tuesday of the month. No tickets will be sold for that day's drawing after 9:15p.m.
19. Drawings will be on that Tuesday at 9:30 p.m. After the drawing at 9:30 p.m. all tickets sold to that point will be discarded.
20. Tickets for the next drawing will then start again and continue until 9:15p.m. on the next drawing date.
21. In case of emergency and the raffle cannot be held at the designated time, the raffle will be held at the first available date following.
22. Owners, employees and any suppliers for the raffle, co-chairs and key holders of the F.O.P. are NOT eligible to purchase raffle tickets for the Jack of Spades drawing.
